I led the preparation of a full suite of pre-planning reports including a Transport Assessment, Travel Plan and Flood Risk Assessment for a 670 dwelling development including community centre.

Working for promoter Manor Oak Homes I devised an access solution for the development. As part of the Transport Assessment an extensive study was undertaken of the potential impact on the surrounding highway infrastructure. I undertook negotiations with the highway authority to agree a solution to the predicted impact at the A10 / A142 junction. This work ultimately saw the planning application approved by the planning committee.

Countess Manor, Moulton

My team provided Travel Plan Co-ordination (TPC) services for a 145 dwelling development on behalf of Taylor Wimpey. I led the team in designing appropriate literature along with developing a marketing and surveying strategy to monitor progress towards the targets. Services provided included provision of travel information packs to all residents and undertaking annual surveys to understand travel patterns and potential shifts in behaviour.

I provided expert advice and supported Travis Perkins through the appeal process after local objectors raised concerns regarding the drainage strategy (designed by others) and the potential for increased flood risk caused by the proposed development on the site.
